Revisions:

Documentation: For physicians out of training greater than two (2) years, an activity report and/or operative report(s) will need to be submitted from a facility that is accredited by an organization holding “deemed status” granted by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) that is able to provide the number of procedures and/or activity performed at that facility during the past two (2) years **unless otherwise noted under initial requirements.**

Privilege 30.13-Minor Core – Newborn: Privileges to admit, evaluate, diagnose, perform history and physical exam and treat newborns **from 0 to 28 days** (normal, physiologic jaundice and peripartum hypoglycemia).

cases required Init App: **6 acute care or 12 office cases specifying performance of newborn well check or newborn progress note**
